Purpose of Request:

Create new Chapter 10.92 within Title 10 of the Official Code of Hall County, Georgia entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" for the purpose of investigating and installing of speed tables in residential subdivisions, and to establish the evaluation and design criteria pertaining to speed tables.

Facts and Issues:

Options:

Speed tables can only be considered for roadways classified as local or residential with a speed limit of 30mph or less determined in accordance with State and County law. Roadways classified by Hall County and the Georgia Department of Transportation as collector, arterial or above are not eligible for speed tables.

If the resident or neighborhood association wishes to proceed, petition forms will be provided. It will be the applicant's responsibility to obtain affirmative signatures from at least 75% of property owners within the subdivision. If approved by the Board of Commissioners, a contractor will be secured to complete the installation. Hall County will pay the cost of installation and the cost will be divided between the properties within the subdivision and added to property tax bills as a traffic calming assessment. After the installation costs are provided for, an annual maintenance fee of \$12.00 per property will continue.
