This is the first grant for the Hall County Central Communications 911 has received from the Georgia Emergency Communications Authority within the Georgia Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (GEMA). However, Hall County has received many grants for Emergency Management and Sheriff's Office over the past several years from GEMA.
