**RESOLUTION TO AMEND PROVISIONS OF THE HALL COUNTY**  
**CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING DECALS FOR MOBILE HOMES**  
**AND MANUFACTURED HOMES**

**WHEREAS**, the Georgia General Assembly amended the Official Code of Georgia Annotated Section 48-5-492 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated regarding procurement and display of decals on mobile homes and manufactured homes during the 2021 Legislative Session; and

**WHEREAS**, the revised state law provides that the display of such decals is in discretion of the local government; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Commissioner of Hall County has determined that the display of decals on mobile homes and manufactured homes is not necessary for the efficient administration of duties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Commissioner has requested that the Board of Commissioners amend Sections 3.90.020 and 3.90.040 of the Official Code of Hall County Georgia;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HALL COUNTY DOES HEREBY RESOLVE** as follows:

1.

Section 3.90.020 is hereby deleted in its entirety, and the following Section 3.90.020 is inserted in lieu thereof as follows:

“3.90.020. – Manufactured homes.

A. Owners of manufactured homes locating in Hall County after January 1 of any year shall be required to report their manufactured homes to the office of the tax commissioner within ten working days.”

2.

Section 3.90.040 is hereby deleted in its entirety, and the following Section 3.90.040 is inserted in lieu thereof as follows:

“3.90.040. – Penalties; venue for prosecution.

A. Any person, firm, corporation, association or partnership which shall fail to do anything required by this chapter as the same exists or as it may hereafter be amended shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, amenable to the process of the Magistrate or State Court of Hall County, and upon conviction, shall be punished as provided in the Official Code of Hall County, Georgia section 1.50.020 for each violation in the discretion of the court.”

3.

Any and all laws or parts of laws in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

4.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
